WHY DO WE DO A RECITAL?



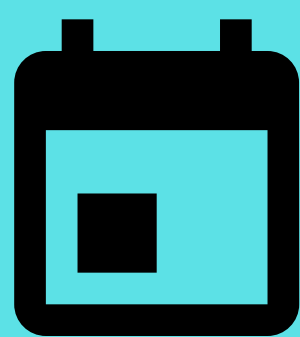
- Performance is a key component to dance

- Costume bills sent via email
- Students are measure in class
- Costumes distributed in April

BACKSTAGE PROCEDURES



- Students are checked in, walked back to their room by a teacher
- Students remain backstage for the entire performance, except for Twinkle Babies and Twinkle Stars who will be allowed to be checked out during intermission
- Students are supervised by volunteers
- Volunteer sign-ups go up in March
