



# RECITAL TICKET SALES FAQS

## **When do tickets go on sale?**

Tickets will go on sale April 20, 2026 at 10:00am. We highly recommend purchasing right when sales open, as shows sell quickly!

## **Where do I purchase tickets?**

Tickets must be purchased directly through the Macomb Center for the Performing Arts website: [www.macombcenter.com](http://www.macombcenter.com)

Important: Please do NOT purchase tickets from Facebook, resale groups, or any third-party sellers. Anyone offering tickets for sale outside of the official website is a scam.

## **How much are tickets?**

- \$28 per seat online (this price includes all fees—no surprises at checkout!)
- \$32 per seat at the door, if available

## **Do dancers need a ticket?**

No—performers and volunteers do not need a ticket. Dancers will remain backstage for the duration of the show.

## **Can I choose my seats?**

Yes! Seating is reserved, and you will select your seats at the time of purchase. Tickets go quickly, so don't wait!

## **Is there a limit on how many tickets I can buy?**

Yes—there is a 8 ticket limit per order.

## **Can I purchase tickets at the door?**

Yes, tickets may be available at the door for \$32, but availability is not guaranteed.

## **What is your refund policy?**

All ticket sales are final. No refunds or exchanges.

## **Do I need to print my tickets?**

Digital tickets are accepted; however, we recommend printing your tickets if possible. This helps make entry smoother and easier for the wonderful senior volunteers assisting at the theater.

## **What time should we arrive?**

Doors open 45 minutes prior to showtime. Please arrive on time so we can avoid guests entering the theater during dances.

## **Are babies or young children free?**

No—everyone must have a ticket, including babies and young children. Lap sitting is not permitted per fire code, and every guest must have their own seat.
